

**CITY OF MIDDLETOWN
ORDINANCE NO. 10-09-2025-A
AN ORDINANCE REVISING 39.11
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING
TO THE CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD**

WHEREAS, the City of Middletown ordinances relating to its Code Enforcement Board have a penalty provision that should be revised to be more consistent to penalty sections in other City ordinances to avoid confusion and inconsistencies,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIDDLETOWN, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1: Ordinance Section 39.11 is hereby repealed and replaced as follows:

39.11 POWER TO UPHOLD, MODIFY OR IMPOSE HIGHER PENALTIES

The Code Enforcement Board has the authority to uphold the fine imposed by the Code Enforcement Officer for any citation for which an appeal has been heard. The Board also has the authority for good cause shown to waive all or a portion of a penalty, or to impose a higher fine than assessed by the Code Enforcement Officer. The fine for ordinance violations shall be no less than \$100 and no more than \$500 per violation.

SECTION 2:

This ordinance shall take effect upon enactment and publication according to law.
